

TURNING POINT - PROTEST MARCH IN ALBOX

17th January



The Association held a protest march in Albox on 17 January. The march was well supported, with around 800+ members and supporters. The Mayors of Albox and Cantoria accompanied the marchers. A petition was presented to the Mayor of Albox by the President of the Association at the Town Hall doors. Various Spanish and English speaking media, including the BBC also attended. The President has had a number of "on air" radio interviews with local radio stations to publicise the formation and objectives of the Association, to gain support for its cause and to ask people to join as members. There have also been several press releases. This will be ongoing.

Two meetings have so far been held with the Mayor of Albox, with the objective of the Association gaining information about the Plan General for Albox. It is hoped to have further contact with him for this purpose.
